

## OVERLAY APPLICATION WITH ONE COMPONENT

This application would be for the client who would only want a thin coat of product over her natural nails.

### Preparation

1. Sanitize you and your client's hands.
2. Gently push back cuticles.
3. Lightly buff nails, removing shine.
4. Dust off well with dust brush.
5. Wipe nails with Prep & Clean, using a lint free pad, to remove oils and dust and to disinfect.

### Application

1. Apply a thin even layer of One Component over prepared natural nail. Cure 2 minutes in a UV light unit or 90 sec in a UV/LED. (DO NOT REMOVE the dispersion film, it ensures proper adhesion to 2<sup>nd</sup> Coat.)
2. Apply a 2<sup>nd</sup> thicker coat over the first; stay clear of cuticle and sidewalls. Cure 2 minutes in a UV light unit or 90 sec in a UV/LED.
3. Repeat with 3<sup>rd</sup> coat, thinner than your second, but thicker than your first, as a sealer layer. Being sure again not to get product on the cuticle. Cure 2 minutes in a UV light unit or 90 sec in a UV/LED.
4. Wipe off dispersion film with Prep & Clean. If product is applied smooth enough you will find no filing or sealing will be necessary.

If you need to perfect the finished shape, file to refine shape or surface, buff smooth, and clean with Prep & Clean. Finally apply One Component again or Sealer in usual manner, as described above.

The nails now have a high gloss finish and the overlay is complete.
